Structure and contents

The meeting is focused on the [specific thematic indication](#) for TPG B “**establishing the distribution of work and responsibilities among the competent institutions that have the right knowledge and capacity to carry out recognition procedures**”. Furthermore, the meeting offers an opportunity to share information on the state of art of the activities linked to the TPG B on LRC and to present documents developed in the framework of the Erasmus+ umbrella project “[TPG-LRC Constructing Recognition in the EHEA](#)” (TPG-LRC CoRE).

Structure and contents of the events:

- **First part of the meeting:** panellists will be asked to identify priorities and ways forward to further strengthen cooperation among stakeholders to improve recognition processes. This topic is addressed from the point of view of National Authorities, ENIC-NARIC Centres, Higher Education Institutions, Quality Assurance agencies and students.
- **Second part of the meeting:** the deliverables to develop within the “TPG-LRC CoRE” project over the three priorities of Micro-credentials, Digital technology for the recognition agenda, and Quality of recognition will be presented. Thereafter, the TPG B meeting will be entirely focused to the peer-support activity. Participants will be divided into smaller groups to work on the three specific priorities abovementioned 1) Micro-credentials 2) Digital technology for the recognition agenda and 3) Quality of recognition. In each group, participants will be asked to comment on the chosen topic sharing experiences, needs and perspectives to identify concrete steps toward the implementation of the three priorities.
