DRAFT LETTER (SPECIMEN) TO COUNTRIES

Proposal to the BFUG from AG3 on Dealing with Non-Implementation

GOOD IMPLEMENTATION:

Dear NAME, BFUG representative of COUNTRY

The cyclical model adopted by ministers aims to facilitate peer-support between countries at different stages of implementation of the Bologna Key Commitments. The Implementation report on the Bologna Key Commitments has highlighted that COUNTRY has had considerable success in implementing all three key commitments of the Bologna Process.

We would therefore like to ask COUNTRY to consider how it may best disseminate its success through peer-support to BFUG member countries that are currently facing challenges with implementing these same commitments. Peer-support may take many forms, some more resource intensive than others, so we would ask you to forward your suggestion on how, and through what means, COUNTRY feels it may best disseminate its expertise on implementation to other BFUG members, to the Implementation Committee by DATE. Please provide details on which key commitment(s) COUNTRY would be willing to offer peer-support, as well as the number of colleagues to whom it would be offered.

Please include in your response a list of people or stakeholders that may be able to offer peer-support or peer counselling to aid implementation of one or more key commitment. The Implementation Committee will then put the identified people in contact with colleagues in an EHEA country facing challenges with implementation.

The Implementation Committee will then put the identified people in contact with colleagues from an EHEA country that has had success in implementing the key commitment(s) concerned and that is able to provide peer-support of the type required by COUNTRY.
