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



- Based on the individual needs of HEIs, a tandem of two Bologna experts provides tailor made counselling during two on-site or digital visits
- The counselling focuses on the development of practical reforms at HEIs as well as on solving identified problems through methods of peer learning



The Bologna Key Commitments:

- three-cycle system compatible with the QF-EHEA and first and second cycle degrees scaled by ECTS
- recognition of qualifications in compliance with the Lisbon Recognition Convention
- quality assurance in compliance with the Standards and Guidelines for Quality Assurance in the EHEA

Further issues such as:

- formulation of learning outcomes
- curriculum development/modularisation
- innovative approaches to learning and teaching (e.g. digitalisation)
- mobility and internationalisation


