

### Law n. 148 / 2002






### The concept



# **World Map by Continent**







### Comments/Additional Information

In order to access to higher education courses in Italian institutions it is necessary to hold the "Diploma di Esame di Stato conclusivo dei corsi di istruzione secondaria superiore" (State Exam Diploma upon the conclusion of the higher secondary school course) - commonly known as "Diploma di Maturità".

The "Diploma di Esame di Stato conclusivo dei corsi di istruzione secondaria superiore" is obtained after passing the relevant State Exam (called Maturity) which is accessed with a decision taken by the class council in the final scrutiny in the last class of a study course followed in a Liceo (Lycoum), istituto tecnico (technical institute) or istituto professionale (professional institute), and afer a total of 13 years of schooling, divided into 5 years of primary school, 3 years of lower secondary school and the

The State Exam is structured in three written tests (in some cases four) and an oral component. The first two written tests are on a national level: one is common to all the study majors, while the second is specific to the major attended. The third written test depends on each exam commission. The oral test is based on the specific learning outcomes of the course and in relation to the subjects taught in the last year of study. The final grade of the State Exam is expressed in hundredths (from 60/100 - the minimum passing grade - to 100/100 - the maximum); the exam commission can award "cum laude" with a

The sample of the diploma obtained after passing the State Exam at the end of the course of studies, valid from school year 2020/2021, has been adopted by the Ministerial Decree n. 88 of the Ministry of Education dated 6 August 2020. As per the abovementioned decree, each student is awarded the "Curriculum dello Studente", which supplies information on knowledge, competences and skills that the student acquired during the course of study.


Each state has at least 1 university (the state of São Paulo, for example, has th Education is administered at the federal, state and municipal levels.





### SUBSTANTIAL DIFFERENCE

Article VI.1, the Lisbon Recognition Convention states that: "To the extent that a recognition decision is based on the knowledge and skills certified by the higher education qualification, each Party shall recognize the higher education qualifications conferred in another Party, unless a substantial difference can be shown between the qualification for which recognition is sought and the corresponding qualification in the Party in which recognition is sought".

A definition of substantial differences only appeared in **2019** in the text of the UNESCO Global Convention on the Recognition of Qualifications concerning Higher Education.


"Significant differences between the foreign qualification and the qualification of the Party that would most likely prevent the applicant from succeeding in the desired activity such as, but not limited to, further study, research activities or employment opportunities".

- related to the **elements** of the qualification
- related to the elements/structure of the foreign higher education **system**
- related to the **modality of achievement** of the qualification.


# Italian Professional Association of Credential Evaluators

- Requirements for knowledge, skills autonomy and responsibilities", establishes the requirements relating to the activity of the Credential Evaluator from the definition of specific tasks and related contents in terms of knowledge and skills, up to the ethical and deontological aspects of the profession.

This document specifies the requirements relating to the professional activity of the credential evaluator, i.e. the expert in the evaluation and recognition of academic and professional qualifications. The credential evaluator has advanced professional skills in the management of recognition procedures and in the evaluation and comparison of qualifications, with knowledge of the different models of education and training at national and international level.

These requirements are specified, starting from the specific tasks and activities and the identification of the related contents, in terms of knowledge and skills, to also clearly identify the level of autonomy and responsibilities in line with the National Qualifications Framework (NQF).
