- Incorporate into the text of the Communique recommendations/suggestions received by the Board and BFUG.
- Minutes of the meetings of the Drafting Committee are published only when the meeting is not convened exclusively for working on the draft text of the Communique.





#### Draft structure of the Tirana Communiqué (I)

#### **1. Introduction** – *half a page*

- We, Ministers, ... Place and date of the meeting of Ministers;
- Bologna Process/EHEA general context; figures and goals;
- Higher Education in general continuity and new trends;
- Mention role of Higher Education for democratic societies; social cohesion and inclusion, making Europe unique [here, and/or under 2 within the topics Fundamental Values and/or Social Dimension];
- Socio-economic situation affecting the EHEA -> improvements needed -> EHEA's role to progress;
- Aftermath of the pandemic;
- Effects on HE of Geopolitical changes HE promoting peace; discussion on strategic autonomy? Situation regarding Ukraine and after the decisions of suspension of participation of Russian Federation and Belarus;
- [San Marino: implementation status].





#### Draft structure of the Tirana Communiqué (II)

- 2. Progress in implementing agreed reforms / Goals achieved / Things to go until 2027 (next workplan) two pages: Topics elaborated within the work plan of the current BFUG period, by the various BFUG substructures (by timeframe-progress or by topic, to be decided for draft 0) Take stock of progress in 2024, project specific objectives for 2024-2027.
- Renewed Agenda after the Rome Communique and in light of the international discussions;
- Trends, changes regarding "the three I's" of the Rome Communique [inclusive, innovative, interconnected];
- Implementation of the Bologna Key commitments via peer support (WG1 Monitoring and BICG/TPG A, B, C);
- Fundamental Values of the EHEA, including participation of students and staff (WG2);
- The Social Dimension of the EHEA: new framework, implementation and monitoring <> Socio-economic situation affecting the EHEA -> improvements needed -> EHEA's role to progress (WG3);



### Draft structure of the Tirana Communiqué (III)

## (2. Progress in implementing agreed reforms / Goals achieved / Things to go until 2027 cont.d)

- Inclusive and innovative approaches to learning and teaching (WG4);
- Transnational cooperation in higher education, research and innovation, through synergies between the EHEA and the European Research Area (ERA) and the European Education Area (EEA);
- EHEA outreach and question of introducing "EHEA [Global] Dialogue Partners" (CG GPD).
- Further themes/topics:
  - Mobility and cross-disciplinary and cross-border cooperation;
  - SDGs, sustainability;
  - Artificial Intelligence in Education;
  - QA: ESG revision;
  - ...?





#### Draft structure of the Tirana Communiqué (IV)

- **3. Priorities of the EHEA beyond 2027** one page: Refer more generally to Rome Communique vision until 2030, have Ministers promote a vision beyond 2030, what are we working on, "looking into topics such as..."
- Aspects internal to the EHEA;
- Contribution of the EHEA to realising the SDGs 2030/sustainability and/or the influence of the EHEA on the future SDG realisation [here, or rather under 2./3., or as overarching topic within several topics];
- External Space for CG1 Contribution of the EHEA to realising the SDGs 2030/sustainability [here or in introduction].

- San Marino Roadmap group: Good implementation status, Roadmap as instrument for all further accessions;
- Governance of the EHEA post 2030;
