





Figure 1 - "Major topics of advice for prospective students from refugee backgrounds in Germany, in 2019 [B2.14]" (Wissenschaft Weltoffen 2021)

 A credential is defined as a digital document containing information about a subject (i.e. a person), a statement (i.e. vaccination status) and an issuer, certifying the former.





Data management practices must be **standardised**, making data **machine-readable**




Digital Credentials are a **common good**. Public funding for the development of **open technologies and standards** is needed


