The Bergen Communiqué

- We ask the BFUG to elaborate and agree on a strategy for the external dimension.
- EHEA should be open and attractive
- Base cooperation on sustainable development in accordance with OECD/UNESCO guidelines
- Academic values should prevail
- EHEA shall be a partner and stimulate cooperation with other parts of the world
- Enhance understanding of the Bologna Process and share experience



- Working for a balanced strategy when it comes to competitiveness, attractiveness, cooperation and capacity building.
- The strategy must be flexible in relation to different parts of the world.
- The development of a strategy for the external dimension should take into account the OECD/UNESCO guidelines for quality provision in Cross-Border Higher Education.
