In a generally positive context, matters for discussion and consideration are:

- how to **improve participation** in the TPG activities
- how to stimulate less active countries
- how to ensure
 - that both those needing support and those willing to give it participate fully and pro-actively
 - that the 'basics' of the Key Commitments continue to be at the centre of the TPGs' attention, while not stifling the natural desire to focus on 'trendy' (but also relevant and important) side issues
 - coordination within countries
