



Dear BFUG Secretarial,

With this letter, the Ministry of Education, Sport and Youth (MEoYS) announces Albania's candidacy for hosting the next Ministerial Conference of the Ministers of Higher Education of the European Higher Education Area (EHEA) and to be entrusted of the Bologna Follow Lip Group (BFUG) secretariat responsibility.

In the last few years, Albania has played an active role within BFUG and the different working and advisory groups. Guided by the Bologra Process principles, Albania has implemented higher education reforms, which demonstrate our determination to fully implement the Bologna key commitments and to contribute to the development of the European Higher Education Area.

As a part of the Berlin process, Albania has been uniquely placed to be an important player and facilitator of the cooperation within the Western Balkan countries. We have so far undergone important work in the field of recognition of academic and professional qualifications, confirmed by the endorsed declaration in Poznan on the recognition of Higher Education Qualifications, and the agreement on roaming signed about one year ago. We intend to use what we have learned from this process in forging deeper connections with our neighbors, as we all strive to improve our education systems in the path toward joining the European Union.

Hosting the ministerial conference as well as the BFUG secretariat, immediately after France and Italy, constitutes an important challenge for us, which will most certainly prove to be an impetus for Albania's continued improvement of its higher education system. It will also be a good example for other EHEA countries not yet part of the EU in their engagement for the realization of Bologna key commitments.




- ❖ will support Albania in the process of the reforms in the field of HE,

- ❖ will contribute to fulfillment of obligations for Albania EU integration in the HE field.








## Proposed structure of the BFUG secretariat 2020-2023\*


