to monitor the harmonization of the minimum **standards** set down in the study curricula for veterinary surgeons in the European Union Directive 2005/36, enacted through the European System of Evaluation of Veterinary Training (ESEVT), managed by the EAEVE having joint responsibility with the Federation of **Veterinarians of Europe (FVE)**





The EAEVE/FVE evaluation system gives assurance to:

- the public to know they can trust the quality of graduating veterinary surgeons and the service they deliver,
- the veterinary students to know their education reaches agreed and acceptable standards,
- the veterinary establishments to know that their curricula and School, reach the U.E. agreed benchmarked level.





Concept

internal European professional peer evaluation systems of veterinary educational establishments.

Function

The basic detailed procedures are set out in the **Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs).**

All this is to drive the **harmonization** of research-based **specifically veterinary education** and its constant evolution in the context of societal and economic challenges.
