

 Definition: composition of the student body entering, participating in and completing higher education at all levels should correspond to the heterogeneous social profile of society at large

New: fosters equity New enlarged definition: the social dimension encompasses the creation of an inclusive environment in higher education that fosters equity and diversity and is responsive to the needs of local communities

 New: integrate the principles into the core higher education mission: learning and teaching, research, innovation, knowledge exchange and outreach New: responsive to the needs of local communities

New: fosters diversity

 New: integrate the principles into the core higher education mission: institutional governance and management, policies for empowering students and staff

We need to <u>develop a framework for the implementation</u> of the **Principles and Guidelines!**






Attendance Rate

78%




Attendance Rate

Coordination with the BFUG working structures

Coordination with the WG on Learning and Teaching:

- Agreed to have coordination meetings every 1-2 months
- 1st coordination meeting: 20 January 2022
- 2nd coordination meeting: 31 March 2022
- 3rd coordination meeting: 3 May 2022
- 4th coordination meeting: 15 July 2022 > Co-chairs guests at the dinner 29 September 2022

Coordination with the WG on Monitoring the implementation of the Bologna Process:

- 1st coordination meeting: 8 July 2021
- 2nd coordination meeting: 6 October 2021
- 3rd coordination meeting: 13 June 2022
- 4th coordination meeting: 29 September 2022

Achievements 2021-2022

- ✔ Peer-learning activities (PLA) in 2021 and in 2022
 - Last meeting: Autonomy Scorecard (EUA), Bologna with Student Eyes (ESU), Monitoring system (Eurydice)
- ✓ Erasmus+ project proposal successfully applied on the KA3 call in October 2021 > approved for funding in March 2022 > project started on June 1, 2022:
 - the project "Peer Learning Activities and Resources to Underpin the Principles and Guidelines for Social Dimension" should support fulfillment of the objectives of the BFUG WG on Social Dimension
 - Project coordinator: Flemish Community, Department of Education and Training, Belgium-Flanders
 - Partners: SIHO-Support Centre Inclusive Higher Education (Belgium), Ministry of Education and Science (Croatia), Institute for the Development of Education (Croatia), European Students' Union

Creation of 3 Subgroups on Social Dimension

3 Subgroups established within the WG on Social Dimension - on 17 February 2022:

- Subgroup 1 > coordinator Berto Bosscha (The Netherlands) > 11 members
- Subgroup 2 > coordinator Martina Darmanin (ESU) > 11 members
- Subgroup 3 > coordinator Nino Schmidt (Croatia) > 11 members

Subgroups goals:

- 1. Propose indicators for each Principle for social dimension
 - > PHASE 1: February-September 2022
- 2. Propose monitoring mechanism for each Principle for social dimension
 - > PHASE 2: October-December 2022

Conclusions of the Malta meeting

- Dominant **approach to indicators** > in the form of <u>statements</u> which signal that a principle is operationalized through SMART (specific, measurable, achievable, relevant, time-bound) activities:
 - Revision and regrouping > into <u>main indicators and subindicators</u> > now we have 4-5 main indicators + each indicator has a set of subindicators
 - We have used and <u>incorporated Eurydice's indicators</u> (primarily as main indicators)
 - We have marked Eurydice's indicators
 - WG SD list of indicators is more comprehensive than the Eurydice's list, but encompasses almost all Eurydice-indicators

Conclusions of the Malta meeting

- Indicators > statements // system of monitoring = questions
 - Monitoring could be implemented through the Bologna Implementation Report, through the Eurydices's questionnaire on fostering equity and inclusion and through national quality assurance agencies
- We should <u>create explanation/toolbox/'preambula'</u> on how to use indicators and system of monitoring
 - Importance of visualizations of final outputs > importance of being user friendly ('traffic light approach')
 - Consider having on-line version of the toolbox

Conclusions of the Hague meeting

• New Erasmus+ project:

- present the project at the meeting in Brussels and inform WG members on the main activities of the project
- Establish cooperation with ENQA and EQAR:
 - if the ESGs are revised, propose to include statements related to social dimension enhancement
- Organize one more round of internal WG SD consultation on indicators and create a new version of indicators for social dimension principles:
 - A new version of the indicators should be confirmed in Brussels, prior to being submitted to the WG on Monitoring for the 2024 Bologna Implementation Report

Conclusions of the Brussels meeting

- Draft list of indicators finalised, sent to BFUG
- The indicators will be used by the WG on Monitoring for BPIR
- Proposal to annex the list of indicators to the Tirana Communique
- The nature and name of the 'subindicators' to be determined
- Discussion on the type of qualitative/quantitative indicators
