ENQA's strategic plan 2016-2020

- **VISION:** A European Higher Education Area where students have access to high quality education and can achieve qualifications that are respected world-wide.
- **GOALS:** 2. Services: ENQA is a reference point for European quality assurance in the international context.

Workplan 2015-2016

- Involvement in and cooperation with:
INQAAHE, CHEA, C-RAC, ANQAAHE, APQN, AQAN, AFRIQan...
For information sharing, attendance of events, collaboration in projects (different levels of engagement)
- QACHE project: Co-operate with ANQAAHE, APQN and TESQA (Australia) on QA of CBHE
- SHARE project: Co-operate with the DAAD (as well as British Council, Campus France and EP-NUFFIC) on development of a regional quality assurance approach in the ASEAN
- AFRICA QA project: Co-operate with the University of Barcelona, the DAAD, the AAU and the EUA on development of a regional quality assurance approach in Africa (“ASG” and an agency review methodology)
- EQuAM and EQTeL projects: partner in a consortium supporting the reinforcement of the QA system in Jordan (IQA offices/QA of elearning)
- Ad hoc capacity building activities on request (e.g. Central Asia)

Current priorities and focus areas

- Capacity building in QA and alignment of various standards and procedures with the European QA framework; dialogue on QA of HE
- Support for the establishment and development of independent QA agencies; review of QA agencies
- Focus on ASEAN and Africa
